# SUBSTANCE WEEKLY REPORT

## Sept 2 - Sept 8, 2024 (74 Samples)



#### HIGHLIGHTS

- 41.9% (31/74) of samples checked were as expected, with no cuts or adulterants detected
- 33.3% (10/30) of down samples contained a benzo this week
- This weekend our staff were discussing the future of Substance at our yearly strategic planning retreat

#### **DOWN/OPIOIDS, 30 SAMPLES**

- 14 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 7%
- 8 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at a median concentration of 8%
- 4 samples contained ortho-Methyl fentanyl at a median concentration of 4%
- 10/30 down samples contained a benzo
  - 10 samples contained bromazolam at a median concentration of 3%

#### Community Reporting

- **Down**: Small rust coloured pebbles. Cooked fast and turned flakey. When smoked, it smelt terrible, burnt black with a black residue. Effects were much weaker than expected, the reporter was expecting a benzo but the sample showed no signs of it. Purchased north of downtown.
- **Down**: Purple powder. When smoked it tasted like a benzo was present. Effects were somewhat stronger than expected. Purchased in Rock Bay.
- Down: Small purple pebbles. When smoked it tasted strong. Effects were somewhat stronger than expected and felt like a benzo was present. Purchased north of downtown.
- **Down**: Small brown pebbles. Effects were somewhat weaker than expected. Reporter described it as a "ripoff". Purchased north of downtown.
- **Down**: Big purple chunks. Cooked and remained purple. When smoked, the resin was thick. Effects were somewhat weaker than expected, felt like a benzo was present and had poor "legs". Purchased north of downtown.

#### **BENZOS, 6 SAMPLES**

- 0/5 samples were alprazolam (Xanax)
  - 2 samples were **bromazolam** instead
  - 3 samples did not have any actives detected
- 1 sample was bromazepam

#### **UNKNOWN, 5 SAMPLES**

- 5 samples were brought in as "unknown"
  - 5 had actives detected

#### **DISSOCIATIVES & PSYCHEDELICS, 8 SAMPLES**

- 3/3 samples were **ketamine**
- 1/2 samples were 2C-B
  - 1 sample was 4-HO-DiPT and MDMA instead
- 1 sample was 4-HO-DiPT instead of 4-HO-MET
- 1 sample was 4-AcO-DMT instead of DMT
- 1 **psilocybin (mushrooms)** sample did not have any actives detected

## STIMULANTS, 21 SAMPLES

- 11/11 samples were **cocaine** (hard and soft)
- 8/9 samples were MDMA/MDA
  - 1 MDMA sample was meth instead
- 1 sample was methamphetamine

#### **Community Reporting**

- Meth/side: Clear shards. Cooked clear and smelt of dill pickles. Effects were as expected. Purchased north of downtown.
- Meth/side: White shards. Cooked normally, turning clear. When smoked, it tasted more bitter than usual. Effects were as expected. Purchased north of downtown.

### **OTHER, 4 SAMPLES**

- 1 sample was GHB
- 1 xylazine sample was MDA and MDMA instead
- 1 cannabis sample had no actives detected
- 1 kratom sample had no actives detected





### **REPORT GLOSSARY**

- **Median:** Like an average, but accounts for outlying results so the final number isn't skewed.
- **No cuts or adulterants detected:** This does not mean these samples were "pure", impurities likely exist at concentrations below our limits of detection.
- **No actives detected:** We could not detect any active ingredients within our PSMS target list.
- **Percentages:** Represents the amount per 100 mg. Example: a concentration of 12% fentanyl is 12 mg of fentanyl per 100 mg (a point) of the total sample (including other components like cuts).
- **Unknown benzo:** A benzo that is likely outside of our PSMS target list.

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
