SUBSTANCE WEEKLY REPORT

Sept 23 - Sept 29, 2024 (159 Samples)



HIGHLIGHTS

- 43.4% (69/159) of samples checked were as expected, with no cuts or adulterants detected
- 29.2% (21/72) of down samples contained a benzo this week

DOWN/OPIOIDS, 72 SAMPLES

- 59 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 11%
- 12 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at a median concentration of 3%
- 20 samples contained ortho-Methyl fentanyl at a median concentration of 3%
- 1 sample contained **carfentanil** at 0.1%
- 8 samples contained **xylazine** at a median concentration og 0.3%
- 7 samples contained **heroin** at a median concentration of 3%
- 21/72 down samples contained a benzo
 - 19 samples contained **bromazolam** at a median concentration of 4%
 - 1 sample contained **etizolam** at 0.4%
 - 1 sample contained an unknown benzo

Community Reporting

- **Down:** Small bright pink pebbles. When cooked, turned a light caramel colour. When smoked, produced a sticky but pretty normal resin. Effects were much stronger than expected, causing immediate nodding off. Bought in downtown area.
- Down: Small purple pebbles. When smoked, had a very strong taste. Effects were somewhat stronger than expected, felt like it had high concentration of benzos. Bought north of downtown.

BENZOS, 3 SAMPLES

- 1 sample was lorazepam (Ativan)
- 1 alprazolam (Xanax) sample was bromazolam instead
- 1 unspecified benzo sample was bromazolam

DISSOCIATIVES & PSYCHEDELICS, 18 SAMPLES

- 10/10 samples were **ketamine**
- 2 samples were 2C-B
- 3 samples were **LSD** (acid)
- 1/2 samples were **DMT**
 - 1 sample 5-MeO-DMT instead of DMT
- 1 mescaline sample was methallylescaline instead

UNKNOWN, 18 SAMPLES

- 18 samples were brought in as "unknown"
 - 17 had actives detected, 1 did not

STIMULANTS, 30 SAMPLES

- 15/16 samples were **cocaine** (hard and soft)
 - 1 cocaine (soft) sample also contained levamisole
- 9/10 samples were **MDMA/MDA**
 - 1 MDMA sample also contained MDA
- 2/2 samples were **methamphetamine**
- 1 sample was **4-MMC**
- 1 sample was MDA instead of MDPV

Community Reporting

• **Meth/side:** Clear crystal shards. When cooked, turned clear and congealed quickly. When smoked, tasted and melted as expected. Effects were as expected, nothing unusual.

OTHER, 18 SAMPLES

- 2/2 samples were GHB
- 2/6 samples were hydromorphone (Dilaudid)
 - 2 hydromorphone samples were N-propionyl para-fluoro norfentanyl base instead
 - 2 hydromorphone samples were metonitazene instead
- 1 Percocet sample also contained phenacetin
- 1 sample was **bupropion**
- 1 sample was a mixture of MDA and tadalafil (Cialis)
- 1 testolone sample was methandrostenolone instead
- 6 health supplement samples had no actives detected

REPORT GLOSSARY

- **Median:** Like an average, but accounts for outlying results so the final number isn't skewed.
- **Percentages:** Represents the amount per 100 mg. Example: a concentration of 12% fentanyl is 12 mg of fentanyl per 100 mg (a point) of the total sample (including other components like cuts).
- Unknown benzo: A benzo that is likely outside of our PSMS target list.
- **Metonitazene:** A synthetic opioid that is estimated to be similar in potency to fentanyl.
- **N-propionyl para-fluoro norfentanyl base:** A by-product of fluorofentanyl synthesis with limited information about its potency.
- **Bupropion:** An antidepressant medication that is now also used in smoking cessation.
