SUBSTANCE WEEKLY REPORT

Dec 2 - Dec 8 2024 (109 Samples)



HIGHLIGHTS

- 59.6% (65/109) of samples checked were as expected, with no cuts or adulterants detected
- 29.8% (17/57) of down samples contained a benzo this week

DOWN/OPIOIDS, 57 SAMPLES

- 48 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 8%
- 3 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at concentrations of 0.2%, 0,3%, and 5%
- 15 samples contained ortho-Methyl fentanyl at a median concentration of 10%
- 6 samples contained **xylazine** at a median concentration of 0.2%
- 2 samples contained heroin at concentrations of 1.7% and 2.3%
- 17/57 down samples contained a benzo
 - 14 samples contained bromazolam at a median concentration of 4%
 - 3 samples contained an unknown benzo
 - 2 samples contained alprazolam (Xanax) at concentrations of 0.3% and 5.1%
 - 2 samples contained **flubromazepam** at concentrations of 1.8% and 5.4%

Community Reporting

- **Down:** White powder. When smoked, tasted like a benzo was present. Effects were stronger than expected, felt very sedative like a benzo was present.
- **Down:** Purple powder. When smoked, had a very strong taste. Effects were stronger than expected - felt like benzo-dope.
- **Down:** Small light pink pebbles. When cooked, melted very slowly and was very sticky. Had no taste when smoked. Effects were much weaker than expected. Bought downtown.

DISSOCIATIVES & PSYCHEDELICS, 7 SAMPLES

- 4/4 samples were **ketamine**
- 1 sample was 2C-B
- 2 samples were **LSD** (acid)

BENZOS, 5 SAMPLES

- 2 alprazolam (Xanax) samples were flualprazolam instead
- 2 samples were clonazepam (Klonopin)
- 1 sample was etizolam and an unknown

OTHER, 12 SAMPLES

- 1 sample was GHB
- 1 sample was zopiclone
- 3 samples were **hydromorphone** (Dillaudid)
- 1 sample was morphine
- 1 oxycodone (Oxycontin) sample was hydromorphone (Dillaudid) instead
- 4 samples were sildenafil (Viagra) and tadalafil (Cialis)
- 1 **nandrolone** sample did not have any actives detected

UNKNOWN, 1 SAMPLES

- 1 samples were brought in as "unknown"
 - 1 had actives detected

STIMULANTS, 27 SAMPLES

- 10/11 samples were **cocaine** (hard and soft)
 - 1 cocaine (hard) sample also contained Fentanyl and ortho-Methyl fentanyl
- 7/8 samples were **MDMA**
 - 1 MDMA sample also contained methamphetamine
- 1/2 samples were MDA
 - 1 MDA sample was MDMA instead
- 6/6 samples were **methamphetamine**

Community Reporting

- **Cocaine (hard):** yellow chunks with powder. When cooked, slowly melts. When smoked, has a pungent taste. Effects somewhat stronger than expected. Bought in the downtown area.
- **Cocaine (hard):** White chunks. When smoked, melted well and had minimal taste. Effects were just as expected. Bought north of downtown.
- **Cocaine (hard):** When cooked, turned clearish with an oily slick. When smoked, made a popping sound. Effects were much weaker than expected. Bought north of downtown.
- **Meth/side:** Clear shards. When cooked, stayed clear in colour. Tasted and melted as normally when smoked. Effects as expected, nothing unusual. Bought north of downtown.
- **Meth/side:** Large clearish chunks. When smoked had a really strong, bitter taste. Effects were as expected. Bought in North Park area.
- **Meth/side:** Large clearish chunks. When smoked had a really strong, gross taste. Effects were as expected. Bought in North Park area.



REPORT GLOSSARY

- **Community Reporting:** These sections include reports from community members throughout Victoria. Samples within these sections may or may not have been checked at Substance.
- **Median:** Like an average, but accounts for outlying results so the final number isn't skewed.
- **Percentages:** Represents the amount per 100 mg. Example: a concentration of 12% fentanyl is 12 mg of fentanyl per 100 mg (a point) of the total sample (including other components like cuts).
- Unknown benzo: A benzo that is likely outside of our PSMS target list.
- Nandrolone: An anabolic steroid
