SUBSTANCE WEEKLY REPORT Nov 25 - Dec 1, 2024 (101 Samples)



HIGHLIGHTS

- 50.5% (51/101) of samples checked were as expected, with no cuts or adulterants detected
- 28.8% (15/52) of down samples contained a benzo this week

DOWN/OPIOIDS, 52 SAMPLES

- 42 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 6%
- 8 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at a median concentration of 0.7%
- 10 samples contained **ortho-Methyl fentanyl** at a median concentration of 0.7%
- 4 samples contained **xylazine** at a median concentration of 0.2%
- 3 samples contained **heroin** at concentrations of 0.8%, 1.6%, and 36%
- 15/52 down samples contained a **benzo**
 - 12 samples contained **bromazolam** at a median concentration of 2%
 - 3 samples contained **desalkylgidazepam** at concentrations of 1.4%, 1.4%, 15.3%
 - 1 sample contained **flubromazepam** at 3%

Community Reporting (from last week)

- **Down:** White powder. When cooked, turned a light caramelish brown. When smoked, tasted very strong and bitter. Effects were much stronger than expected, felt like it was all benzo. Purchased downtown.
- **Down:** Brown powder. When smoked, tasted strong. Effects were as expected. Felt like a benzo was present. Purchased north of downtown.

DISSOCIATIVES & PSYCHEDELICS, 11 SAMPLES

- 6/6 samples were **ketamine**
- 1 sample was 2C-B
- 1 sample was LSD (acid)
- 1 sample was **mescaline**
- 2 tucibi samples contained cocaine, ketamine, MDA, MDMA, and phenacetin



BENZOS, 1 SAMPLES

• 1 unspecified benzo was flualprazolam



OTHER, 2 SAMPLES

- 1 sample was oxycodone (Oxycontin)
- 1 sample was tadalafil (Cialis)

UNKNOWN, 9 SAMPLES

- 9 samples were brought in as "unknown"
 - 7 had actives detected, 2 did not




STIMULANTS, 26 SAMPLES

- 11/12 samples were **cocaine** (hard and soft)
 - 1 cocaine (soft) sample also contained levamisole
- 8/11 samples were MDMA
 - 1 sample also contained **MDA**
 - 1 sample was **melatonin** instead
 - 1 sample was **methamphetamine** and **fentanyl or an analogue** instead
- 1 MDA sample also contained MDMA
- 1 sample was **methamphetamine**
- 1 sample was 3-MMC (Metaphedrone)

Community Reporting (from last week)

- **Cocaine:** Big white chunks. Cooked slowly and tasted salty when smoked. Effects were as expected. Purchased north of downtown.
- **Meth/side:** Big clear chunks. When smoked, tasted gross and burnt fast. Effects were much weaker than expected. Purchased in Rock Bay.



REPORT GLOSSARY

- **Community Reporting:** These sections include reports from community members throughout Victoria. Samples within these sections may or may not have been checked at Substance.
- Median: Like an average, but accounts for outlying results so the final number isn't skewed.
- **Percentages:** Represents the amount per 100 mg. Example: a concentration of 12% fentanyl is 12 mg of fentanyl per 100 mg (a point) of the total sample (including other components like cuts).
- Unknown benzo: A benzo that is likely outside of our PSMS target list.
- **Tucibi:** "pink cocaine" or "tucibi", commonly confused with 2C-B is often a mixture of ketamine, MDMA, and cocaine
