SUBSTANCE WEEKLY REPORT

Jan 27th - Feb 2nd 2025 (127 Samples)



HIGHLIGHTS

- 59.1% (75/127) of samples checked were as expected, with no cuts or adulterants detected
- 24.5% (12/49) of down samples contained a benzo this week

DOWN/OPIOIDS, 49 SAMPLES

- 38 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 7%
- 16 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at a median concentration of 3%
- 17 samples contained **ortho-Methyl fentanyl** at a median concentration of 1%
- 2 samples contained **xylazine** at concentrations of 0.1% and 9%
- 12/49 down samples contained a **benzo**
 - 9 samples contained **bromazolam** at a median concentration of 4%
 - 2 samples contained an unknown benzo
 - 1 sample contained **desalkylgidazepam** at a concentration of 2.5%
 - 1 sample contained **etizolam** at a concentration of 8.1%
 - 1 sample contained **flualprazolam** at a concentration of 1%

Community Reporting

- **Down**: Light pink powder. When cooked, melted quickly and turned in to a dark brown goo. When smoked, hardly had a taste. Much stronger than expected, felt like it had a lot of benzo present. Bought in downtown Victoria.
- **Down**: Small off white pebbles. When cooked, melted to a light brown colour. When smoked, tasted strongly like mint - reporter wonders if a mint type of cutting agent was added to batch. Felt very heavy with benzo - reporter notes that it seems like even people that are used to benzodope are nodding off quickly and hard to wake up. Bought in downtown Victoria.
- **Down**: Small brown pebbles. When smoked, turned black with sugar burning. Effects were much weaker than expected. Bought north of downtown area.

BENZOS, 8 SAMPLES

- 1/4 samples were alprazolam (Xanax)
 - 1 sample was bromazolam instead
 - 1 sample was flualprazolam instead
 - 1 sample did not have any actives detected
- 2/3 samples were bromazolam
 - 1 sample also contained desalkylgidazepam
- 1 etizolam sample also contained desalkylgidazepam

DISSOCIATIVES & PSYCHEDELICS, 12 SAMPLES

- 10/10 samples were **ketamine**
- 1 sample was 2C-B
- 1 sample was mescaline

UNKNOWN, 6 SAMPLES

- 6 samples were brought in as "unknown"
 - 6 had actives detected



STIMULANTS, 49 SAMPLES


- 29/32 samples were **cocaine** (hard and soft)
 - 1 cocaine (hard) sample also contained phenacetin
 - 1 cocaine (soft) sample also contained levamisole
 - 1 cocaine (soft) sample did not have any actives detected
- 12/13 samples were MDMA
 - 1 MDMA sample was cocaine (soft) instead
- 1 sample was methamphetamine
- 2/3 samples were **4-MMC (Mephedrone)**
 - 1 sample was 4-CMC (Clephedrone) instead

Community Reporting

- Meth/side: Clear crystal shards. When smoked it tasted like dill pickles. Effects as expected, nothing unusual.
- **Cocaine base/crack**: Small white pebbles. When smoked, tasted floral. Effects were nice, but felt like it wasn't strong enough. Bought north of downtown area.

OTHER, 2 SAMPLES

- 1 hydromorphone (Dilaudid) sample did not have any actives detected
- 1 sample was tadalafil (Cialis)



REPORT GLOSSARY

- **Community Reporting:** These sections include reports from community members throughout Victoria. Samples within these sections may or may not have been checked at Substance.
- **Median:** Like an average, but accounts for outlying results so the final number isn't skewed.
- **Percentages:** Represents the amount per 100 mg. Example: a concentration of 12% fentanyl is 12 mg of fentanyl per 100 mg (a point) of the total sample (including other components like cuts).
- **Unknown benzo:** A benzo that is likely outside of our PSMS target list.
