# **SUBSTANCE WEEKLY REPORT** Feb 24<sup>th</sup> - Mar 3<sup>rd</sup> 2025 (113 Samples)



## HIGHLIGHTS

- 54.0% (61/113) of samples checked were as expected, with no cuts or adulterants detected
- 38.3% (18/47) of down samples contained a benzo this week

## DOWN/OPIOIDS, 47 SAMPLES

- 43 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 6%
- 9 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at a median concentration of 4%
- 17 samples contained **ortho-Methyl fentanyl** at a median concentration of 3%
- 3 samples contained **xylazine** at concentrations of less than 0.5%
- 1 sample contained **heroin** at a concentration of 3%
- 18/47 down samples contained a **benzo** 
  - 11 samples contained **bromazolam** at a median concentration of 5%
  - 7 samples contained **desalkylgidazepam** at a median concentration of 3
  - 1 sample contained **etizolam** at a concentration of 3%

### <u>Community Reporting (from last week)</u>

- **Down**: Small dark purple pebbles. When smoked, reporter notes that "it seems to keep lighting on fire in the tin foil". Had a weak taste, melted fast, and leaves a black residue. Effects as expected. Bought downtown.
- **Benzo dope**: Small purple pebbles. When smoked, tastes great, melts awesome, produces a lot of resin. Bought in North Park area.

#### **DISSOCIATIVES & PSYCHEDELICS, 14 SAMPLES**

- 10/10 samples were ketamine
- 1 DXM (dextromethorphan) sample was levomethorphan instead
- 1 sample was 5-MeO-DMT
- 1 sample was LSD (acid)
- 1 **5-methoxytryptamine** sample contained an **unknown** instead

## **BENZOS, 10 SAMPLES**

- 2/6 samples were alprazolam (Xanax)
  - 1 sample was bromazolam instead
  - 3 samples were an **unknown benzo** instead
- 1 sample was clonazepam (Klonopin)
- 1 sample was lorazepam (Ativan)
- 1 sample was N-desalkylflurazepam
- 1 sample was pyrazolam

## **OTHER, 2 SAMPLES**

- 1 sample was desmetramadol (O-DSMT)
- 1 **sodium borohydride** sample contained an **unknown mineral** instead

## STIMULANTS, 36 SAMPLES

- 16/18 samples were **cocaine** (hard and soft)
  - 1 cocaine (soft) sample also contained phenacetin and procaine
  - 1 cocaine (soft) sample also contained levamisole
- 1 sample was MDA
- 8/8 samples were MDMA
- 5/5 samples were **methamphetamine**
- 1 sample was 2-MMC
- 1 sample was 3-FPM
- 1 3-MMA sample also contained an unknown
- 1 sample was lisdexamfetamine dimesylate (Vyvanse)

#### Community Reporting (from last week)

- **Cocaine HCI/soft**: Fine white powder. Effects somewhat stronger than expected, got a really numb tongue when it was snorted. Bought downtown.
- **Side/Meth**: Clear crystal shards. When smoked, stayed a clear colour. Tasted awfully bitter, more than usual. Felt like a strange cut was present, turned black with a little heat. Effects a big stronger than expected. Bought downtown.



## **UNKNOWN, 4 SAMPLES**

4 samples were brought in as "unknown"
3 had actives detected, 1 did not



## **REPORT GLOSSARY**

- **Community Reporting:** These sections include reports from community members throughout Victoria. Samples within these sections may or may not have been checked at Substance.
- **Median:** Like an average, but accounts for outlying results so the final number isn't skewed.
- **Percentages:** Represents the amount per 100 mg. Example: a concentration of 12% fentanyl is 12 mg of fentanyl per 100 mg (a point) of the total sample (including other components like cuts).
- Unknown benzo: A benzo that is likely outside of our PSMS target list.
