

# SUBSTANCE WEEKLY REPORT



Mar 17<sup>th</sup> - Mar 23<sup>rd</sup> 2025 (134 Samples)

## HIGHLIGHTS

- 48.9% (66/135) of samples checked were as expected, with no cuts or adulterants detected
- 26.2% (16/61) of down samples contained a benzo this week

## DOWN/OPIOIDS, 61 SAMPLES

- 39 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 7%
- 35 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at a median concentration of 12%
- 11 samples contained **ortho-methyl fentanyl** at a median concentration of 1%
- 8 samples contained **heroin** at a median concentration of 2%
- 1 sample contained **xylazine** at a concentration of 0.1%
- 16/61 down samples contained a **benzo**
  - 11 samples contained **bromazolam** at a median concentration of 2%
  - 5 samples contained **desalkylgidazepam** at a median concentration of 4%
  - 2 samples contained **etizolam** at concentrations of 0.2% and 2%
  - 2 samples contained an **unknown benzo**

### Community Reporting (from last week)

- **Down:** Small purple pebbles. When smoked, had a nice resin and tasted very strongly of benzos. Effects very strong, felt like it had heavy benzo.
- **Down:** Small purple pebbles. When cooked, turned dark purple. When smoked, had a very weak taste and melted slowly. Effects were unexpectedly strong.

## DISSOCIATIVES & PSYCHEDELICS, 17 SAMPLES

- 8/10 samples were **ketamine**
  - 2 samples also contained **phenacetin**
- 1 sample was **2C-B**
- 1 **5-MeO-MiPT** sample contained an **unknown** instead
- 1 **ETH-LAD** sample was **AL-LAD** instead
- 3/3 samples were **LSD (acid)**
- 1 **Tucibi** sample contained **2C-B, lidocaine, ketamine, and MDMA**

## BENZOS, 8 SAMPLES

- 0/3 samples were **alprazolam (Xanax)**
  - 2 samples were **bromazolam** instead
  - 1 sample was **flualprazolam** instead
- 2/2 samples were **avizafone**
- 2/3 samples were **clonazepam (Klonopin)**
  - 1 sample was **ketamine and MDMA** instead

## OTHER, 2 SAMPLES

- 2/2 samples were **GHB**

## UNKNOWN, 0 SAMPLES

- 0 samples were brought in as "unknown"

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## STIMULANTS, 46 SAMPLES

- 24/25 samples were **cocaine** (hard and soft)
  - 1 **cocaine (soft)** sample also contained **levamisole**
- 1 **MDA** sample was **MDMA** instead
- 11/12 samples were **MDMA**
  - 1 sample was **MDA** instead
- 4/5 samples were **methamphetamine**
  - 1 sample also contained **fenfanyl or an analogue**, likely due to cross contamination
- 2 **3-FPM** samples were **2-MMC** instead
- 1 sample was **lisdexamfetamine dimesylate (Vyvanse)**

### Community Reporting (from last week)

- **Meth/Side:** Clear crystal shards. When cooked, it turned clear. When smoked, turned very dark very fast. Produced very dark resin and more resin than usual. Effects were somewhat stronger than expected. Bought in North Park area.



## REPORT GLOSSARY

- **Community Reporting:** These sections include reports from community members throughout Victoria. Samples within these sections may or may not have been checked at Substance.
- **Median:** Like an average, but accounts for outlying results so the final number isn't skewed.
- **Percentages:** Represents the amount per 100 mg. Example: a concentration of 12% fentanyl is 12 mg of fentanyl per 100 mg (a point) of the total sample (including other components like cuts).
- **Unknown benzo:** A benzo that is likely outside of our PSMS target list.
