SUBSTANCE WEEKLY REPORT

Mar 24th - Mar 30th 2025 (135 Samples)



HIGHLIGHTS

- 43.0% (58/135) of samples checked were as expected, with no cuts or adulterants detected
- 32.3% (21/65) of down samples contained a benzo this week

DOWN/OPIOIDS, 65 SAMPLES

- 43 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 4%
- 32 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at a median concentration of 4%
- 6 samples contained **ortho-methyl fentanyl** at a median concentration of 6%
- 7 samples contained **heroin** at a median concentration of 15%
- 4 samples contained **xylazine** at a median concentration of 0.1%
- 21/65 down samples contained a benzo
 - 12 samples contained **bromazolam** at a median concentration of 3%
 - 6 samples contained desalkylgidazepam at a median concentration of 7%
 - 3 samples contained an **unknown benzo**
 - 1 sample contained etizolam at a concentration of 5%

Community Reporting

• **Down**: Bright pink pebbles. When cooked, turns dark and brown. When smoked, tasted bitter. Effects were as expected.

DISSOCIATIVES & PSYCHEDELICS, 13 SAMPLES

- 6/6 samples were ketamine
- 1 sample was **O-PCE**
- 3/3 samples were 2C-B
- 1 sample was 2C-H
- 2/2 samples were **LSD** (acid)



BENZOS, 5 SAMPLES

- 1 alprazolam (Xanax) sample was bromazolam instead
- 1 sample was avizafone
- 1 sample was etizolam
- 1/2 samples were lorazepam (Ativan)
 - 1 sample was diazepam (Valium) instead



UNKNOWN, 1 SAMPLES

- 1 sample was brought in as "unknown"
 - 1 sample had actives detected

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STIMULANTS, 46 SAMPLES

- 17/18 samples were **cocaine** (hard and soft)
 - 1 cocaine (hard) sample was fentanyl and methamphetamine instead
- 4/12 samples were MDMA
 - 4 samples also contained MDA
 - 4 samples were MDA instead
- 3/3 samples were **methamphetamine**
- 1 sample was 2-MMC
- 0/3 samples were **3-MMC**
 - 2 samples were 2-MMC instead
 - 1 sample was **3-CMC** and **eutylone** instead
- 1 4-FMA sample contained an unknown instead
- 2/2 samples were 4-MMC
- 1 sample was amphetamine

Community Reporting (from last week)

- Cocaine base/Hard: White chunks with blue spots. When cooked, turned clear and when smoked tasted strong. Effects were somewhat stronger than expected with unexpected sedative effects.
- **Meth/side**: Clear purple shards. Melted good. Effects were the same as expected.
- **Meth/side**: Clear shards. When smoked, tasted of dill pickle. Effects were somewhat stronger than expected.

OTHER, 10 SAMPLES

- 1/4 samples were **GHB**
 - 3 samples also contained GBL
- 1/2 samples were hydromorphone (Dilaudid)
 - 1 sample was oxycodone (Oxycontin) instead
- 2/3 samples were **oxycodone** (**Oxycontin**)
 - 1 sample was hydromorphone (Dilaudid) instead
- 1 Percocet sample contained an unknown instead



REPORT GLOSSARY

- **Community Reporting:** These sections include reports from community members throughout Victoria. Samples within these sections may or may not have been checked at Substance.
- **Median:** Like an average, but accounts for outlying results so the final number isn't skewed.
- **Percentages:** Represents the amount per 100 mg. Example: a concentration of 12% fentanyl is 12 mg of fentanyl per 100 mg (a point) of the total sample (including other components like cuts).
- Unknown benzo: A benzo that is likely outside of our PSMS target list.
