SUBSTANCE WEEKLY REPORT

Mar 3rd - Mar 9th 2025 (112 Samples)



HIGHLIGHTS

- 55.4% (62/112) of samples checked were as expected, with no cuts or adulterants detected
- 40% (8/20) of down samples contained a benzo this week

DOWN/OPIOIDS, 20 SAMPLES

- 14 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 5%
- 7 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at a median concentration of 11%
- 2 samples contained **heroin** at concentrations of 2% and over 50%
- 8/20 down samples contained a benzo
 - 4 samples contained **bromazolam** at a median concentration of 1%
 - 2 samples contained **desalkylgidazepam** at concentrations of 10% and 13%
 - 2 samples contained an **unknown benzo**

Community Reporting

- **Down**: Small purple pebbles. When cooked, melted slow but turned black and left a residue. Tasted bitter when smoked. Effects were stronger than expected, definitely felt like benzodope.
- **Down**: Small purple pebbles. When smoked, resin is good and tasted strongly of a benzo. Effects were as expected, strong. Bought around the North Park area.

OTHER, 11 SAMPLES

- 1 GHB sample also contained GBL
- 1 sample was zolpidem (Ambien)
- 1 sample was morphine
- 0/3 samples were **oxycodone (Oxycontin)**
 - 3 samples were acetaminophen (Tylenol) instead
- 1/2 samples were **Percocet**
 - 1 sample contained **isotonitazene** instead
- 1 **alcohol (ethanol)** sample contained an unknown
- 1 testosterone cypionate was trenbolone enanthate instead

BENZOS, 19 SAMPLES

- 0/9 samples were **alprazolam (Xanax)**
 - 3 samples were **bromazolam** instead
 - 6 samples were an **unknown benzo** instead
- 1 sample was **Avizafone**
- 4/5 samples were **bromazolam**
 - 1 sample also contained **isotonitazene**
- 1 clonazepam (Klonopin) sample was bromazolam instead
- 2/2 diazepam (Valium) samples were an unknown benzo instead
- 1 etizolam sample was bromazolam instead

STIMULANTS, 41 SAMPLES

- 15/19 samples were cocaine (hard and soft)
 - 1 cocaine (soft) sample was methamphetamine instead
 - 1 cocaine (soft) sample did not have any actives detected
 - 1 cocaine (hard) sample was fentanyl instead
 - 1 cocaine (hard) sample also contained bromazolam, fentanyl, and fluorofentanyl
- 1 sample was MDA
- 12/13 samples were MDMA
 - 1 sample contained an **unknown** instead
- 2/2 samples were methamphetamine
- 1 3-MMC sample was 2-MMC instead
- 1/2 samples were 4-MMC
 - 1 sample was 2-MMC instead
- 1 Adderall sample was methamphetamine instead
- 1 amphetamine sample was methamphetamine instead
- 1 sample was dextroamphetamine (Dexedrine)

Community Reporting

- **Cocaine base/crack**: Small white chunks. When smoked, tasted sweet and produced a dark resin. Much stronger than expected and had a surprising sedative effect. Bought north of downtown area.
- **Meth/Side**: Clear crystal shards. When smoked, it meted and tasted like it normally does, effects were as expected, nothing unusual or unexpected to report.

DISSOCIATIVES & PSYCHEDELICS, 16 SAMPLES

- 9/9 samples were ketamine
- 3/4 samples were 2C-B
 - 1 sample was MDMA instead
- 1 sample was 5-MeO-MiPT (Moxy)
- 2 samples were **LSD**

REPORT GLOSSARY

- **Community Reporting:** These sections include reports from community members throughout Victoria. Samples within these sections may or may not have been checked at Substance.
- **Median:** Like an average, but accounts for outlying results so the final number isn't skewed.
- **Percentages:** Represents the amount per 100 mg. Example: a concentration of 12% fentanyl is 12 mg of fentanyl per 100 mg (a point) of the total sample (including other components like cuts).
- Unknown benzo: A benzo that is likely outside of our PSMS target list.
