

SUBSTANCE WEEKLY REPORT



Apr 7th - Apr 13th 2025 (103 Samples)

HIGHLIGHTS

- 48.5% (50/103) of samples checked were as expected, with no cuts or adulterants detected
- 35.0% (14/40) of down samples contained a benzo this week

DOWN/OPIOIDS, 40 SAMPLES

- 31 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 4%
- 19 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at a median concentration of 5%
- 1 sample contained **ortho-methyl fentanyl** at a concentration of 0.7%
- 1 sample contained **heroin** at a concentration of 1%
- 1 sample contained **xylazine** at a concentration of 0.1%
- 2 samples contained **medetomidine** at concentrations of 0.4% and 0.6%
- 14/40 down samples contained a **benzo**
 - 8 samples contained **bromazolam** at a median concentration of 4%
 - 4 samples contained **desalkylgidazepam** at a median concentration of 2%
 - 3 samples contained an **unknown benzo**
 - 1 sample contained **etizolam** at a concentration of 1%
 - 1 sample contained **flualprazolam** at a concentration of 0.3%

Community Reporting (from last week)

- **Down:** Small light green pebbles. When cooked, turned in to a light sticky caramel type substance. When smoked, had a weak taste. Effects were stronger than expected, felt very benzo heavy. Bought downtown.
- **Down:** Light blue powder. Stayed a light blue colour when cooked and dissolved normally. Effects were much stronger than expected, very sedative, felt like a benzo or tanq was present. Bought downtown.

BENZOS, 9 SAMPLES

- 1/7 samples were **alprazolam (Xanax)**
 - 3 samples were an **unknown benzo** instead
 - 2 samples were **bromazolam** instead
 - 1 sample was **flubromazepam** instead
- 1 sample was **clonazepam (Klonopin)**
- 1 sample was **lorazepam (Ativan)**

OTHER, 5 SAMPLES

- 1 **GHB** sample also contained **GBL**
- 1 **hydromorphone (Dilaudid)** sample did not have any actives detected
- 1 sample was **morphine**
- 1/2 samples were **oxycodone (Oxycontin)**
 - 1 sample was **N-desethyl isotonitazene** instead

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STIMULANTS, 31 SAMPLES

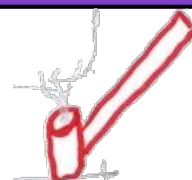
- 11/12 samples were **cocaine** (hard and soft)
 - 1 **cocaine (hard)** sample also contained **fentanyl or an analogue**
- 10/10 samples were **MDMA**
- 1 sample was **MDA**
- 2/2 samples were **methamphetamine**
- 1 samples was **2-MMC**
- 4/4 samples were **4-MMC (Mephedrone)**
- 1 sample was **5-MAPB**

Community Reporting (from last week)

- **Side/meth:** Clear/cloudy crystals. Went clear when cooked, tasted very bitter when smoked. Effects as expected. Bought north of downtown area.
- **Side/meth:** Clear crystal shards. When smoked, melted really well and resin was good. Had unusual effects, felt sleepy right away after smoking. Bought downtown.

DISSOCIATIVES & PSYCHEDELICS, 17 SAMPLES

- 3/4 samples were **ketamine**
 - 1 samples also contained **MDMA**
- 1 **5-MeO-DMT** sample also contained **DMT** and an **unknown**
- 7/7 **5-MeO-DMT Base** samples contained **5-MeO-DMT** and an **unknown** instead
- 1 sample was **DMT**
- 3/3 samples were **LSD (acid)**
- 1 sample was **mescaline**



UNKNOWN, 1 SAMPLES

- 1 sample was brought in as "unknown"
 - 1 sample had actives detected



REPORT GLOSSARY

- **Community Reporting:** These sections include reports from community members throughout Victoria. Samples within these sections may or may not have been checked at Substance.
- **Median:** Like an average, but accounts for outlying results so the final number isn't skewed.
- **Percentages:** Represents the amount per 100 mg. Example: a concentration of 12% fentanyl is 12 mg of fentanyl per 100 mg (a point) of the total sample (including other components like cuts).
- **Unknown benzo:** A benzo that is likely outside of our PSMS target list.
