SUBSTANCE WEEKLY REPORT

June 16th - June 22nd, 2025 (144 Samples)



HIGHLIGHTS

- 66.0% (95/144) of samples checked were as expected, with no cuts or adulterants detected
- 21.6% (8/37) of down samples contained a benzo this week

DOWN/OPIOIDS, 37 SAMPLES

- 18 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 9%
- 18 samples contained fluorofentanyl at a median concentration of 4%
- 7 samples contained carfentanil at a median concentration of 0.1%
- 1 sample contained heroin at a concentration of greater than 50%
- 1 sample contained xylazine at a concentration of 0.7%
- 1 sample contained medetomidine at a concentration of 2%
- 8/37 down samples contained a **benzo**
 - 6 samples contained bromazolam at a median concentration of 5%
 - 2 samples contained an **unknown benzo**

Community Reporting

- **Down**: Small light blue pebbles. When smoked, had a sweet taste, melted easily and produced a light resin. Effects somewhat stronger than expected, felt like a benzo was present. Bought in Burnside area.
- Down: Small brown pebbles. When smoked, melted very slowly. Effects as expected, lasted a nice long time.
- **Down**: Large brown chunks. When cooked, stayed brown in colour but did not congeal. When smoked, had a pleasant flavour. Writer also notes: "It was a breeze to smoke and cook". Felt like it did not have a benzo and did not cause any overdose.

BENZOS, 7 SAMPLES


- 1 alprazolam (Xanax) sample was bromazolam instead
- 1 sample was **bretazenil**
- 1/2 samples were **bromazolam**
 - 1 sample was **flualprazolam** instead
- 1 clonazepam (Klonopin) sample was an unknown benzo instead
- 1 sample was diazepam (Valium)
- 1 sample was etizolam

DISSOCIATIVES & PSYCHEDELICS, 18 SAMPLES

- 12/12 samples were ketamine
- 4/4 samples were 2C-B
- 1 sample was 5-MeO-MiPT (Moxy)
- 1 Tucibi sample contained **ketamine** and **MDMA**

UNKNOWN, 8 SAMPLES

- 8 samples was brought in as "unknown"
 - 5 samples had actives detected, 3 did not

STIMULANTS, 57 SAMPLES

- 23/24 samples were **cocaine** (hard and soft)
 - 1 cocaine (soft) sample also contained levamisole
- 16/17 samples were MDMA
 - 1 sample was MDA instead
- 1 MDA sample was MDMA instead
- 2/3 samples were MDMA and MDA
 - 1 sample only contained MDMA
- 6/6 samples were methamphetamine
- 2/2 samples were **4-MMC (Mephedrone)**
- 4/4 samples were amphetamine

Community Reporting

- **Side/meth**: White/clear crystal shards. When smoked had a bitter tasted, melted well, and produced a dark resin. Effects were as expected.
- Cocaine base/crack: Large white chunks. When smoked had a nice flavour, melted well, and produced lots of resin. Effects as expected but writer notes: "High didn't last as long as I thought it would". Bought north of downtown.

OTHER, 17 SAMPLES

- 3/3 samples were GHB
- 2/2 samples were hydromorphone (Dilaudid)
- 1 sample was morphine
- 7/7 samples were Oxycodone (Oxycontin)
- 2/2 Percocet samples were metodesnitazene instead
- 1 semaglutide sample did not have any actives detected
- 1 unknown SARM sample contained ligandrol

REPORT GLOSSARY

- **Community Reporting:** These sections include reports from community members throughout Victoria. Samples within these sections may or may not have been checked at Substance.
- **Median:** Like an average, but accounts for outlying results so the final number isn't skewed.
- Percentages: Represents the amount per 100 mg. Example: a concentration of 12% fentanyl is 12 mg of fentanyl per 100 mg (a point) of the total sample (including other components like cuts).
- **Unknown benzo:** A benzo that is likely outside of our PSMS target list.
