## **SUBSTANCE WEEKLY REPORT** July 7<sup>th</sup> - July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2025 (170 Samples)



## HIGHLIGHTS

- 61.2% (104/170) of samples checked were as expected, with no cuts or adulterants detected
- 40.0% (20/50) of down samples contained a benzo this week

### **DOWN/OPIOIDS, 50 SAMPLES**

- 35 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 6%
- 26 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at a median concentration of 5%
- 1 sample contained **ortho-methyl fentanyl** at a concentration of 2%
- 6 samples contained **carfentanil** at a median concentration of 0.1%
- 1 sample contained **heroin** at a concentration of greater than 50%
- 1 sample contained **xylazine** at a concentration of 0.7%
- 1 sample contained **medetomidine** at a concentration of 2%
- 1 sample contained an **unknown nitazene**
- 20/50 down samples contained a **benzo** 
  - 18 samples contained **bromazolam** at a median concentration of 2%
  - 5 samples contained **desalkylgidazepam** at a median concentration of 2%
  - 2 samples contained an **unknown benzo**

### Community Reporting

• **Down**: Small light purple pebbles. When cooked, congealed quickly. When smoked, melted well, produced minimal resin, and had a light tasted. Effects were somewhat stronger than expected, caused dizziness. Bought downtown.

### **BENZOS, 16 SAMPLES**

- 0/6 samples were alprazolam (Xanax)
  - 1 sample did not have any actives detected
  - 3 samples were **bromazolam** instead
  - 1 sample was diazepam (Valium) instead
  - 1 sample was an **unknown benzo** instead
- 4/4 samples were **avizafone**
- 0/3 samples were **bromazolam** 
  - 1 sample also contained **fluorofentanyl**
  - 3 samples did not have any actives detected
- 1 **ethylbromazolam** sample also contained an fentanyl or an analogue
- 1 sample was etizolam

### DISSOCIATIVES & PSYCHEDELICS, 29 SAMPLES

- 20/20 samples were ketamine
- 3/3 samples were 2C-B
- 1 sample was 4-HO-MET
- 1 5-MeO-DMT sample was DMT instead
- 1 5-MeO-MiPT sample also contained 5-MeO-DBT
- 1 sample was **DMT**
- 1/2 samples were LSD
  - 1 sample did not have any actives detected

### **UNKNOWN, 5 SAMPLES**

- 5 samples were brought in as "unknown"
  - 4 samples had actives detected, 1 did not

## **STIMULANTS, 62 SAMPLES**

- 26/26 samples were **cocaine** (hard and soft)
- 2/3 samples were MDA
  - 1 sample was MDMA instead
- 25/26 samples were MDMA
  - 1 sample was MDA instead
- 5/5 samples were **methamphetamine**
- 2/2 samples were 4-MMC

#### Community Reporting

- **Cocaine HCI**: White powder with small white pebbles. Slightly numbing when consumed. Effects as expected, nothing unusual.
- Meth/Side: Clear shards. When smoked, produced a white resin. Effects nice as expected. Purchased in Rock Bay area

### **OTHER, 8 SAMPLES**

- 1 GHB sample also contained GBL
- 1 xylazine sample also contained fluorofentanyl and an unknown benzo
- 1 hydromorphone (Dilaudid) sample did not have any actives detected
- 1 sample was oxycodone (Oxycontin)
- 1 sample was promethazine
- 1 sample was SR-17018
- 1 sample was tadalafil (Cialis)
- 1 sample was sildenafil (Viagra) and tadalafil (Cialis)



### **REPORT GLOSSARY**

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- **Community Reporting:** These sections include reports from community members throughout Victoria. Samples within these sections may or may not have been checked at Substance.
- **Median:** Like an average, but accounts for outlying results so the final number isn't skewed.
- Percentages: Represents the amount per 100 mg. Example: a concentration of 12% fentanyl is 12 mg of fentanyl per 100 mg (a point) of the total sample (including other components like cuts).
- Unknown benzo: A benzo that is likely outside of our PSMS target list.
