SUBSTANCE WEEKLY REPORT

June 30th - July 6th, 2025 (143 Samples)



HIGHLIGHTS

- 51.7% (74/143) of samples checked were as expected, with no cuts or adulterants detected
- 46.8% (29/62) of down samples contained a benzo this week

DOWN/OPIOIDS, 62 SAMPLES

- 33 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 7%
- 33 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at a median concentration of 5%
- 5 samples contained **ortho-methyl fentanyl** at a median concentration of 3%
- 8 samples contained **carfentanil** at a median concentration of 0.2%
- 5 samples contained heroin at a median concentration of 7%
- 1 sample contained **xylazine** at a concentration of less than 0.1%
- 29/62 down samples contained a benzo
 - 22 samples contained **bromazolam** at a median concentration of 3%
 - 5 samples contained **desalkylgidazepam** at a median concentration of 2%
 - 2 samples contained an **unknown benzo**

Community Reporting (from last week)

- **Down**: Large brown chunks. When cooked, stayed brown and was slow to congeal. Tasted nice when smoked and produced a good resin. Effects as expected. Bought in Burnside area.
- **Down**: Small light purple and white pebbles. When cooked, congealed quickly. When cooked, melted well and produced a light resin. Effects were somewhat stronger than expected, caused dizziness and shortness of breath.
- **Down**: Small purple pebbles. When cooked, congealed quickly. When smoked had a sweet, fenty taste. Effects were expected. Bought in Rock bay area.

BENZOS, 4 SAMPLES

- 1/2 samples were **alprazolam (Xanax)**
 - 1 sample was **desalkylgidazepam** instead
- 2/2 samples were diazepam (Valium)

OTHER, 6 SAMPLES

- 3/3 samples were **1,4-Butanediol**
- 2/2 samples were hydromorphone (Dilaudid)
- 1 sample was oxycodone (Oxycontin)

DISSOCIATIVES & PSYCHEDELICS, 16 SAMPLES

- 7/7 samples were **ketamine**
- 2/2 samples were 2C-B
- 1 sample was 4-HO-MET
- 1 AMT sample was MDMA instead
- 1 sample was **DMT**
- 4/4 samples were **LSD**



STIMULANTS, 51 SAMPLES

- 15/17 samples were **cocaine** (hard and soft)
 - 1 **cocaine** (hard) sample did not have any actives detected
 - 1 **cocaine** (soft) sample also contained levamisole
- 1 sample was MDA
- 23/25 samples were MDMA
 - 1 sample was MDA instead
 - 1 sample was **ketamine** instead
- 2/2 samples were methamphetamine
- 1 sample was 4-MMC
- 1 sample was 6-APB
- 3/4 samples were amphetamine
 - 1 sample did not have any actives detected

Community Reporting (from last week)

• **Side/meth**: White/clear crystals. When cooked, turned white. When smoked, produced a white resin. Effects were stronger than expected. Bought in Rock Bay area.

UNKNOWN, 4 SAMPLES

- 4 samples were brought in as "unknown"
 - 3 samples had actives detected, 1 did not





REPORT GLOSSARY

- **Community Reporting:** These sections include reports from community members throughout Victoria. Samples within these sections may or may not have been checked at Substance.
- Median: Like an average, but accounts for outlying results so the final number isn't skewed.
- **Percentages:** Represents the amount per 100 mg. Example: a concentration of 12% fentanyl is 12 mg of fentanyl per 100 mg (a point) of the total sample (including other components like cuts).
- Unknown benzo: A benzo that is likely outside of our PSMS target list.
