SUBSTANCE WEEKLY REPORT



HIGHLIGHTS

- 63.2% (79/125) of samples checked were as expected, with no cuts or adulterants detecte
- 60.7% (17/28) of down samples contained a benzo this week

DOWN/OPIOIDS, 28 SAMPLES

- 20 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 13%
- 12 samples contained fluorofentanyl
- 17/28 down samples contained a **benzo**
 - 8 samples contained **bromazolam** at a median concentration of 6%
 - 7 samples contained an unknown benzo
 - 2 samples contained desalkylgidazepam

Community Reporting (from last week)

• **Down:** Large purple chunks. When smoked, truned green and blue. Effects as expected, nothing unusual.

- 10/10 samples were ketamine
- 2/2 samples were **3-HO-PCE**
- 1 sample was fluorodeschloroketamine
- 1 MXPR sample also contained 3-HO-PCE

- 1/2 samples were 2C-B
 - 1 sample also contained an unknown
- 1 sample was 2C-I
- 1 sample was 5-MeO-DMT
- 1 sample was **DMT**
- 2/2 samples were LSD
- 1 sample was methylethyltryptamine

BENZOS, 7 SAMPLES

- 1 sample was alprazolam (Xanax)
- 3/3 samples were bretazenil
- 1 sample was clonazepam (Klonopin)
- 1 sample was flubromazepam
- 1 unspecified benzo was bromazolam

OTHER, 11 SAMPLES

- 1 sample was dicloqualone
- 1 sample was GHB
- 1 oxycodone (Oxycontin) sample was **fentanyl** instead
- 1 SR-17018 sample contained an unknown
- 1 **fenbendazole** sample contained an unknown
- 1 **ivermectin** sample contained an unknown
- 2/2 samples were sildenafil (Viagra)
- 1 **growth hormone** sample did not hav any actives detected
- 1 oxymetholone sample was methandrostenolone instead
- 1 **testosterone** sample was **trenbolone** enanthate instead

UNKNOWN, 5 SAMPLES

- 5 samples were brought in as "unknown"
 - 5 samples had actives detected

STIMULANTS, 52 SAMPLES

- 15/16 samples were **cocaine** (hard and soft)
 - 1 cocaine (soft) sample also contained phenacetin
- 15/16 samples were MDMA
 - 1 sample was methamphetamine instead
- 2/2 samples were **methamphetamine**
- 1 sample was 2-FMA
- 2/2 samples were 2-MMC
- 0/3 samples were 3-MMC
 - 3 samples were **2-MMC** instead
- 1 sample was 4-fluoroethylphenidate (4F-EPH)
- 1 sample was 4-MMC
- 1 sample was 4F-MPH
- 1 5-APB sample was 5-MAPB instead
- 2/2 samples were 6-APB
- 1 sample was amphetamine
- 1 sample was eutylone
- 1 sample was N-ethylhexedrone (Hexen)
- 1 sample was alpha-PHiP

Community Reporting (from last week)

- Cocaine base/crack: Small white pebbles. Smoked and melted really well. Effects were nice, as expected. Bought in the downtown area.
- **Cocaine base/crack**: Small white, waxy pebbles. When smoked it, it was different every time: different taste, different resin, and melted differently. Effects as expected.



REPORT GLOSSARY

- Community Reporting: These sections include reports from community members throughout Victoria. Samples within these sections may or may not have been checked at Substance.
- **Median:** Like an average, but accounts for outlying results so the final number isn't skewed.
- Percentages: Represents the amount per 100 mg. Example: a concentration of 12% fentanyl is 12 mg of fentanyl per 100 mg (a point) of the total sample (including other components like cuts).
- Unknown benzo: A benzo that is likely outside of our PSMS target list.
