SUBSTANCE WEEKLY REPORT

November 17th - 23rd, 2025 (155 Samples)



HIGHLIGHTS

- 51.0% (79/155) of samples checked were as expected, with no cuts or adulterants detected
- 37.5% (21/56) of down samples contained a benzo this week

DOWN/OPIOIDS, 56 SAMPLES

- 46 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 6%
- 28 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at a median concentration of 4%
- 10 samples contained **heroin** at a median concentration of 3%
- 7 samples contained medetomidine at a median concentration of 0.9%
- 3 samples contained **ortho-methyl fentanyl** at concentrations of 0.7%, 6%, and 39%
- 2 samples contained fluorofentanyl base at concentrations of 2% and 7%
- 21/56 down samples contained a **benzo**
 - 11 samples contained bromazolam at a median concentration of 3%
 - 6 samples contained **desalkylgidazepam** at a median concentration of 2%
 - 3 samples contained **ethylbromazolam**
 - 3 samples contained an **unknown benzo**
 - 1 sample contained phenazolam

DISSOCIATIVES & PSYCHEDELICS, 12 SAMPLES

- 7/7 samples were **ketamine**
- 1 fluorodeschloroketamine sample was ketamine instead
- 1 sample was 2C-B
- 1 2C-D sample was 5-MeO-MiPT (Moxy) and an unknown instead
- 1 sample was 4-HO-MET (Metocin)
- 1 DOI sample was 2C-B and an unknown instead

BENZOS, 10 SAMPLES

- 1/2 samples were alprazolam (Xanax)
 - 1 sample was bromazolam and fentanyl or an analogue instead
- 1 sample was clonazepam (Klonopin)
- 1/2 samples was diazepam (Valium)
 - 1 sample was **tadalafil (Cialis)** instead
- 1 sample was lorezepam (Ativan)
- 1 sample was rilmazafone
- 1 flubromazolam sample was ethylflualprazolam instead
- 1 gidazepam sample was desalkylgidazepam and ethylflualprazolam instead
- 1 unknown benzo did have any actives detected

OTHER, 11 SAMPLES

- 1 hydromorphone (Dilaudid) sample was fluorofentanyl and an unknown benzo instead
- 2/2 samples were oxycodone (Oxycontin)
- 4/4 samples were **Percocet**
- 1 sample was **SR-17018**
- 1 sample was tadalafil (Cialis)
- 1 oxandrolone sample did not have any actives detected
- 1 2-bromo-3-methylpropiophenone sample did not have any actives detected



STIMULANTS, 54 SAMPLES

- 20/29 samples were **cocaine** (hard and soft)
 - 4 samples also contained **levamisole**
 - 2 samples also contained **phenacetin**
 - 1 sample also contained benzoylecgonine base
 - 1 sample also contained procaine
 - 1 sample did not have any actives detected
- 12/12 samples were MDMA
- 2/2 samples were MDA
- 6/7 samples were **methamphetamine**
 - 1 sample also contained an unknown benzo and fentanyl or an analogue
- 1 sample was **3-MMC**
- 2 samples were 4-MPM
- 1 sample was amphetamine

UNKNOWN, 12 SAMPLES

- 12 samples were brought in as "unknown"
 - 10 samples had actives detected, 2 did not



REPORT GLOSSARY

- **Community Reporting:** These sections include reports from community members throughout Victoria. Samples within these sections may or may not have been checked at Substance.
- Median: Like an average, but accounts for outlying results so the final number isn't skewed.
- **Percentages:** Represents the amount per 100 mg. Example: a concentration of 12% fentanyl is 12 mg of fentanyl per 100 mg (a point) of the total sample (including other components like cuts).
- **Unknown benzo:** A benzo that is likely outside of our PSMS target list.
