SUBSTANCE WEEKLY REPORT

October 27th - November 2nd, 2025 (211 Samples)



HIGHLIGHTS

- 61.6% (130/211) of samples checked were as expected, with no cuts or adulterants detected
- 47.2% (25/53) of down samples contained a benzo this week

DOWN/OPIOIDS, 53 SAMPLES

- 37 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 9%
- 26 samples contained fluorofentanyl at a median concentration of 5%
- 6 samples contained heroin at a median concentration of 2%
- 3 samples contained **ortho-Methyl fentanyl** at concentrations of 0.8%, 7%, and 1%
- 2 samples contained **xylazine** at concentrations of 1% and 9%
- 2 samples contained carfentanil at concentrations of 0.18% and 0.47%
- 1 sample contained **medetomidine** at a concentration of 0.7%
- 25/53 down samples contained a benzo
 - 18 samples contained bromazolam at a median concentration of 5%
 - 5 samples contained **desalkylgidazepam** at a median concentration of 4%
 - 2 samples contained an **unknown benzo**
 - 1 sample contained ethylbromazolam

DISSOCIATIVES & PSYCHEDELICS, 36 SAMPLES

- 16/16 samples were **ketamine**
- 1 O-PCE sample was 3-CMC instead
- 1 FXE sample contained 1 crystal of FXE and another of O-PCE
- 4/6 samples were 2C-B
 - 1 sample also contained ketamine and cocaine
 - 1 sample was **4-MMC** instead
- 1 sample was 3C-P
- 1 sample was 4-AcO-DMT (O-Acetylpsilocin)
- 1 sample was 4-PrO-DMT
- 2/2 samples were **DMT**
- 3/4 samples were **LSD**
 - 1 sample did not have any actives detected
- 2/2 samples were **mescaline**
- 1 tucibi sample contained ketamine and **MDMA**

BENZOS, 17 SAMPLES

- 0/3 samples were alprazolam (Xanax)
 - 2 samples were **bromazolam** instead
 - 1 sample was **ethylbromazolam** instead
- 1 unknown benzo was an unknown benzo
- 1 sample was **bretazenil**
- 1 sample was bromazolam
- 1 sample was desalkylgidazepam
- 1/2 samples were diazepam (Valium)
 - 1 sample was etizolam instead
- 3/3 samples were etizolam
- 3/3 samples were **flualprazolam**
- 1 sample was lorazepam (Ativan)
- 1 midazolam sample was an unknown benzo

STIMULANTS, 81 SAMPLES

- 37/39 samples were **cocaine** (hard and soft)
 - 1 cocaine (soft) sample did not have an actives detected
 - 1 cocaine (soft) sample was bromazolam, fentanyl, and methamphetamine instead
- 30/32 samples were MDMA
 - 1 sample also contained MDA
 - 1 sample was 3,4-MDMA methylene homolog instead
- 0/3 samples were MDA
 - 2 samples were **MDMA** instead
 - 1 sample also contained MDMA
- 1 sample was MDMA and MDA
- 1 sample was methamphetamine
- 1/2 sample were 4-MMC (Mephedrone)
- 3/3 samples was amphetamine

OTHER, 15 SAMPLES

- 1/2 samples were pregabalin
 - 1 sample was etizolam instead
- 3/4 samples were **oxycodone** (**Oxycontin**)
 - 1 sample was N-Propionitrile Chlorphine instead
- 4/8 samples were **Perocet**
 - 3 samples were **fluorofentanyl** instead
 - 1 sample was fentanyl or analogue instead
- 1 citicoline sample did not have any actives detected

UNKNOWN, 9 SAMPLES

- 9 samples were brought in as "unknown"
 - 4 samples had actives detected, 5 did not



REPORT GLOSSARY

- **Community Reporting:** These sections include reports from community members throughout Victoria. Samples within these sections may or may not have been checked at Substance.
- **Median:** Like an average, but accounts for outlying results so the final number isn't skewed.
- **Percentages:** Represents the amount per 100 mg. Example: a concentration of 12% fentanyl is 12 mg of fentanyl per 100 mg (a point) of the total sample (including other components like cuts).
- Unknown benzo: A benzo that is likely outside of our PSMS target list.
