

SUBSTANCE WEEKLY REPORT



February 16th - February 22nd, 2026 (149 Samples)

HIGHLIGHTS

- 48.3% (72/149) of samples checked this week were as expected, with no cuts or adulterants detected
- 42.3% (22/52) of down samples contained a benzo this week

DOWN/OPIOIDS, 55 SAMPLES

- 39 samples contained **fantanyl** at a median concentration of 4%
- 15 samples contained **fluorofantanyl** at a median concentration of 3%
- 9 samples contained **heroin** at a median concentration of 2%
- 1 sample contained **carfantanyl** at a concentration of 6%
- 22/52 down samples contained a **benzo**
 - 8 samples contained **bromazolam** at a median concentration of 3%
 - 8 samples contained **phenazolam**
 - 5 samples contained **ethylbromazolam** at median concentration of 3%
 - 2 samples contained **desalkylgidazepam** at concentrations of less than 0.5% and 2%
 - 1 sample contained an **unknown benzo**
 - 1 sample contained **ethylflualprazolam**

Over the Past Four Weeks...

- 119 samples contained **fantanyl** at a median concentration of 8%
- 79 samples contained **fluorofantanyl** at a median concentration of 9%
- 21 samples contained **bromazolam** at a median concentration of 3%
- 15 samples contained **ethylbromazolam** at a median concentration of 2%
- 5 samples contained **medetomidine** at a median concentration of 1%

BENZOS, 11 SAMPLES

- 2/5 samples were **alprazolam (Xanax)**
 - 1 sample was **etizolam**
 - 1 sample was **desalkylgidazepam**
 - 1 sample was **ethylflualprazolam**
- 1 sample was **desalkylgidazepam**
- 1 sample was **diazepam (Valium)**
- 1 sample was **ethylbromazolam**
- 1 **flualprazolam** sample was **fluorofantanyl** instead
- 2 unspecified samples were **phenazolam**

OTHER, 17 SAMPLES

- 4/5 samples were **hydromorphone (Dilaudid)**
 - 1 sample did not have any actives detected
- 1 **MGM-15** sample did not have any actives detected
- 2/3 samples were **oxycodone (Oxycontin)**
 - 1 sample did not have any actives detected
- 1/3 samples were **Percocet**
 - 1 sample was **ethylflualprazolam** instead
 - 1 sample was an **unknown** instead
- 0/2 samples were **7-hydroxymitragynine (7-OH)**
 - 2 sample did not have any actives detected
- 1 **sildenafil (Viagra)** sample was **Acetaminophen (Tylenol)** instead
- 1 sample was **tadalafil (Cialis)**
- 1 **sec-Butylpropylacetamide** sample was **methamphetamine** instead

STIMULANTS, 33 SAMPLES

- 14/19 samples were **cocaine** (hard and soft)
 - 2 **cocaine** (hard) samples also contained **fentanyl or an analogue**
 - 1 **cocaine** (hard) sample was **fluorofentanyl** instead
 - 1 **cocaine** (soft) sample also contained **levamisole**
- 8/9 samples were **MDMA**
 - 1 sample also contained **methamphetamine**
- 2/2 samples were **methamphetamine**
- 2/2 samples were **3-MMC (Metaphedrone)**
- 1 sample was **amphetamine**

DISSOCIATIVES & PSYCHEDELICS, 23 SAMPLES

- 11/11 samples were **ketamine**
- 1 sample was **2C-B**
- 1 **2C-X** sample was **2C-B** and **dimethylmethcathinone**
- 2/2 samples were **3C-P**
- 1 sample was **4-PrO-MET**
- 2/2 samples were **5-MeO-MiPT**
- 1 **BOD** sample also contained **2C-E** and **methallylescaline**
- 2/2 samples were **mescaline**
- 1 unspecified sample was an **unknown tryptamine**

UNKNOWN, 13 SAMPLE

- 13 samples were brought in as "unknown"
 - 11 samples had actives detected, 2 did not



REPORT GLOSSARY

- **Median:** Like an average, but accounts for outlying results so the final number isn't skewed.
- **Percentages:** Represents the amount per 100 mg. Example: a concentration of 12% fentanyl is 12 mg of fentanyl per 100 mg (a point) of the total sample (including other components like cuts).
- **Unknown benzo:** A benzo that is likely outside of our PSMS target list.
- **Fentanyl or analogue:** Results based on a positive strip test and unconfirmed by PSMS.
