

SUBSTANCE WEEKLY REPORT

February 9th - February 15th, 2026 (191 Samples)



HIGHLIGHTS

- 63.4% (121/191) of samples checked this week were as expected, with no cuts or adulterants detected
- 17.4% (8/46) of down samples contained a benzo this week

DOWN/OPIOIDS, 46 SAMPLES

- 27 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 12%
- 27 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at a median concentration of 8%
- 11 samples contained **heroin** at a median concentration of 2%
- 1 sample contained **ortho-methyl fentanyl** at a concentration of 0.7%
- 8/46 down samples contained a **benzo**
 - 4 samples contained **ethylbromazolam** at a median concentration of 1%
 - 3 samples contained **phenazolam**
 - 2 samples contained **bromazolam** at concentrations of less than 0.5% and 1%
 - 2 samples contained **desalkylgidazepam** at concentrations of less than 0.5% and 1%
 - 1 sample contained an **unknown benzo**

Over the Past Four Weeks...

- 97 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 9%
- 84 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at a median concentration of 9%
- 17 samples contained **ethylbromazolam** at a median concentration of 2%
- 16 samples contained **bromazolam** at a median concentration of 6%
- 8 samples contained **medetomidine** at a median concentration of 1%

BENZOS, 10 SAMPLES

- 3/5 samples were **alprazolam (Xanax)**
 - 1 sample was **clonazepam (Klonopin)** and **phenazolam** instead
 - 1 sample was an **unknown benzo** instead
- 2/2 samples were **clonazepam (Klonopin)**
- 2/2 samples were **diazepam (Valium)**
- 1 sample was **lorazepam (Ativan)**

OTHER, 21 SAMPLES

- 1 sample was **zopiclone**
- 1 **codeine and promethazine (Lean)** sample did not have an active detected
- 9/9 samples were **hydromorphone (Dilaudid)**
- 2/2 samples were **oxycodone (Oxycontin)**
- 0/2 samples were **SR-17018**
 - 1 sample also contained an **unknown**
 - 1 sample only contained an **unknown**
- 1 sample was **bromantane**
- 1 sample was **omberacetam**
- 1 sample was **pramiracetam**
- 1/2 samples were **sildenafil (Viagra)**
 - 1 sample did not have any actives detected
- 1 testosterone sample did not have any actives detected

STIMULANTS, 76 SAMPLES

- 15/17 samples were **cocaine** (hard and soft)
 - 1 **cocaine** (hard) sample did not have any actives detected
 - 1 **cocaine** (hard) sample was **fluorofentanyl** instead
- 29/31 samples were **MDMA**
 - 1 sample was **MDA** instead
 - 1 sample was **sildenafil (Viagra)** instead
- 3/3 samples were **MDA**
- 1 sample was **MDMA** and **MDA**
- 6/6 samples were **methamphetamine**
- 2/2 samples were **3-MMC (Metaphedrone)**
- 11/13 samples were **4-MMC (Mephedrone)**
 - 1 sample also contained **methamphetamine**
 - 1 sample also contained an **unknown**
- 2/3 samples were amphetamine
 - 1 sample was **methamphetamine** instead
- 1 sample was **methylphenidate (Ritalin)**

DISSOCIATIVES & PSYCHEDELICS, 25 SAMPLES

- 12/12 samples were **ketamine**
- 1 sample was **fluorexetamine (FXE)**
- 9/10 samples were **2C-B**
 - 1 sample also contained **acetaminophen**
- 1 sample was **4-HO-MET**
- 1 sample was **LSD**

UNKNOWN, 13 SAMPLE

- 13 samples were brought in as "unknown"
 - 12 samples had actives detected, 1 did not



REPORT GLOSSARY

- **Median:** Like an average, but accounts for outlying results so the final number isn't skewed.
- **Percentages:** Represents the amount per 100 mg. Example: a concentration of 12% fentanyl is 12 mg of fentanyl per 100 mg (a point) of the total sample (including other components like cuts).
- **Unknown benzo:** A benzo that is likely outside of our PSMS target list.
- **Fentanyl or analogue:** Results based on a positive strip test and unconfirmed by PSMS.
