

SUBSTANCE WEEKLY REPORT

January 26th - February 1st, 2026 (133 Samples)



HIGHLIGHTS

- 51.1% (68/133) of samples checked this week were as expected, with no cuts or adulterants detected
- 38.8% (19/49) of down samples contained a benzo this week

DOWN/OPIOIDS, 49 SAMPLES

- 27 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 7%
- 22 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at a median concentration of 13%
- 8 samples contained **heroin** at a median concentration of 11%
- 4 samples contained **medetomidine** at a median concentration of 1%
- 3 samples contained **xylazine** at concentrations of 0.8%, 1%, and 6%
- 1 sample contained **metonitazene** at a concentration of 2%
- 1 sample contained **N-Pyrrolidino Ethylene Isotonitazene**
- 10/31 down samples contained a **benzo**
 - 5 samples contained **phenazepam**
 - 4 samples contained an **unknown benzo**
 - 4 samples contained **bromazepam** at a median concentration of 4%
 - 3 samples contained **ethylbromazepam** at concentrations of 1%, 2%, and 4%
 - 3 samples contained **desalkylgidazepam** at concentrations of .8, 1%, and 14%

Over the Past Four Weeks...

- 110 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 7%
- 102 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at a median concentration of 8%
- 23 samples contained **ethylbromazepam** at a median concentration of 2%
- 20 samples contained **bromazepam** at a median concentration of 6%
- 13 samples contained **medetomidine** at a median concentration of 1%

OTHER, 5 SAMPLES

- 1 sample was **hydromorphone (Dilaudid)**
- 1 **oxycodone (Oxycontin)** sample contained **fluorofentanyl** instead
- 1 **tadalafil (Cialis)** sample was **sildenafil (Viagra)** instead
- 1 **oxandrolone** sample did not have any actives detected
- 1 sample was **testosterone**

BENZOS, 6 SAMPLES

- 0/4 samples were **alprazolam (Xanax)**
 - 2 samples were **ethylflualprazolam** instead
 - 1 sample was **bromazepam** and **desalkylgidazepam** instead
 - 1 sample was **desalkylgidazepam** instead
- 1 sample was **bretazenil**
- 1 unspecified benzo sample was **ethylbromazepam, fentanyl, and fluorofentanyl** instead

STIMULANTS, 50 SAMPLES

- 18/28 samples were **cocaine** (hard and soft)
 - 4 **cocaine** (soft) samples also contained phenacetin
 - 3 **cocaine** (hard) samples did not have any actives detected
 - 1 **cocaine** (hard) sample was methamphetamine instead
 - 1 **cocaine** (hard) sample was fentanyl instead
 - 1 unspecified **cocaine** sample was **fasoracetam** instead
- 13/13 samples were **MDMA**
- 7/7 samples were **methamphetamine**
- 1 sample was **4-MMC (Mephedrone)**
- 1 sample was **methylmethyphenidate (4-MeTMP)**

DISSOCIATIVES & PSYCHEDELICS, 22 SAMPLES

- 11/12 samples were **ketamine**
 - 1 sample also contained an **unknown**
- 1/2 samples was **2C-B**
 - 1 sample also contained **acetaminophen**
- 2/2 samples were **2C-E**
- 1 **2C-I** also contained **2C-B**
- 1 sample was **4-AcO-MET**
- 1 **4-HO-MET** sample also contained **4-HO-MiPT**
- 1 sample was **4-HO-MiPT**
- 1 sample was **allylescaline**
- 1 sample was **LSD**

UNKNOWN, 1 SAMPLE

- 1 sample was brought in as "unknown"
 - 1 sample had actives detected



REPORT GLOSSARY

- **Community Reporting:** These sections include reports from community members throughout Victoria. Samples within these sections may or may not have been checked at Substance.
- **Median:** Like an average, but accounts for outlying results so the final number isn't skewed.
- **Percentages:** Represents the amount per 100 mg. Example: a concentration of 12% fentanyl is 12 mg of fentanyl per 100 mg (a point) of the total sample (including other components like cuts).
- **Unknown benzo:** A benzo that is likely outside of our PSMS target list.
- **Fentanyl or analogue:** Results based on a positive strip test and unconfirmed by PSMS.
