

SUBSTANCE WEEKLY REPORT



April 20th - April 26th, 2026 (205 Samples)

HIGHLIGHTS

- 58.5% (120/205) of samples checked this week were as expected, with no cuts or adulterants detected
- 16.9% (13/77) of down samples contained a benzo this week

DOWN/OPIOIDS, 77 SAMPLES

- 53 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 3%
- 33 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at a median concentration of 7%
- 7 samples contained **medetomidine** at a median concentration of 1%
- 6 samples contained **ortho-methyl fentanyl** at a median concentration of 6%
- 5 samples contained **heroin** at a median concentration of 0.4%
- 13/77 down samples contained a **benzo**
 - 8 samples contained **ethylbromazolam** at a median concentration of 1%
 - 1 sample contained **bromazolam** at a concentration of less than 1%
 - 1 sample contained **desalkylgidazepam** at a concentration of less than 1%
 - 1 sample contained **phenazolam** at a concentration of less than 1%
 - 1 sample contained **ethylflualprazolam**
 - 1 sample contained an **unknown benzo**

Over the Past Four Weeks...

- 144 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 3%
- 102 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at a median concentration of 4%
- 14 samples contained **ethylbromazolam** at a median concentration of 2%
- 13 samples contained **medetomidine** at a median concentration of 1%
- 8 samples contained **phenazolam** at a median concentration of 1%

BENZOS, 22 SAMPLES

- 1/7 samples were **alprazolam (Xanax)**
 - 2 samples were **ethylbromazolam** instead
 - 1 sample was **bromazolam** instead
 - 1 sample was **phenazolam** instead
 - 1 sample was **ethylflualprazolam** instead
 - 1 sample contained an **unknown**
- 7/7 samples were **clonazepam (Klonopin)**
- 2/2 samples were **bromazolam**
- 1/2 samples were **lorazepam (Ativan)**
 - 1 sample was **bromazolam** instead
- 1 sample was **rilmazafone**
- 1 sample was **bretazenil**
- 1 sample was **diazepam (Valium)**
- 1 sample was **ethylbromazolam**

DISSOCIATIVES & PSYCHEDELICS, 18 SAMPLES

- 7/7 samples were **ketamine**
- 1 **fluorexetamine (FXE)** sample was **2-fluoro-2-oxo-PCE** and **O-PCE** instead
- 1 **isophenidine** sample did not match any library entries
- 1 sample was **methoxphenidine (MXP)**
- 2/2 samples were **2C-B**
- 1 **2C-C** sample also contained an unknown
- 1 sample was **2C-T-2**
- 1 **4-AcO-DMT** sample contained **sodium cyanoborohydride** instead
- 1 **5-MeO-MiPT (Moxy)** sample was **5-MeO-DiPT (Foxy)** instead
- 1 sample was **LSD (acid)**

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STIMULANTS, 63 SAMPLES

- 34/36 samples were **cocaine** (hard and soft)
 - 2 **cocaine** (soft) samples also contained **phenacetin**
- 13/14 samples were **MDMA**
 - 1 sample also contained an **unknown**
- 4/6 samples were **methamphetamine**
 - 1 sample was **2C-B** instead
 - 1 sample also contained **fentanyl or an analogue**, due to cross contamination
- 1 sample was **3-MMA**
- 2/2 samples were **3-MMC (Metaphedrone)**
- 1 sample was **4-MMC (Mephedrone)**
- 1 sample was **4-MPM**
- 0/2 samples were **Adderall**
 - 2 samples contained **methamphetamine** instead

OTHER, 12 SAMPLES

- 4/4 samples were **oxycodone (Oxycontin)**
- 3/3 samples were **hydromorphone (Dilaudid)**
- 1 sample was **pregablin**
- 1 sample was **SR-17018**
- 1 sample was **2-bromo-4-methylpropiofenone**
- 1 sample was **sildenafil (Viagra)**
- 1 **tadalafil (Cialis)** sample was **acetaminophen (Tylenol)** and **sildenafil (Viagra)** instead

UNKNOWN, 13 SAMPLES

- 13 samples were brought in as "unknown"
 - 9 samples had actives detected, 4 did not



REPORT GLOSSARY

- **Median:** Like an average, but accounts for outlying results so the final number isn't skewed.
- **Percentages:** Represents the amount per 100 mg. Example: a concentration of 12% fentanyl is 12 mg of fentanyl per 100 mg (a point) of the total sample (including other components like cuts).
- **Unknown benzo:** A benzo that is likely outside of our PSMS target list.
- **Fentanyl or analogue:** Results based on a positive strip test and unconfirmed by PSMS.
