

# SUBSTANCE WEEKLY REPORT



June 8<sup>th</sup> - June 14<sup>th</sup>, 2026 (149 Samples)

## HIGHLIGHTS

- 50.3% (75/149) of samples checked this week were as expected, with no cuts or adulterants detected
- 21.3% (10/47) of down samples contained a benzo this week

## DOWN/OPIOIDS, 47 SAMPLES

- 23 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 4%
- 11 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at a median concentration of 5%
- 7 samples contained **medetomidine** at a median concentration of 0.5%
- 7 samples contained **ortho-methyl fentanyl** at a median concentration of 2%
- 4 samples contained **heroin** at a median concentration of 0.6%
- 9/39 down samples contained a **benzo**
  - 4 samples contained an **unknown benzo**
  - 2 samples contained **ethylbromazolam** at concentrations of 6% and 8%
  - 1 sample contained **bromazolam** at a concentration of 0.6%
  - 1 sample contained **desalkylgidazepam** at a concentration of 2%
  - 1 sample contained **ethylflualprazolam** at a concentration of 1%

### Over the Past Four Weeks...

- 100 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 3%
- 76 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at a median concentration of 6%
- 35 samples contained **medetomidine** at a median concentration of 1%
- 12 samples contained **ortho-methyl fentanyl** at a median concentration of 10%
- 9 samples contained **ethylbromazolam** at a median concentration of 1%

## BENZOS, 15 SAMPLES

- 1/5 samples were **alprazolam (Xanax)**
  - 2 samples were **flualprazolam** instead
  - 1 sample was **desalkylgidazepam** instead
  - 1 sample was **clonazepam (Klonopin)** instead
- 2/3 samples were **diazepam (Valium)**
  - 1 sample was **lorazepam (Ativan)** instead
- 4/4 samples were **lorazepam (Ativan)**
- 1 sample was **ethylbromazolam**
- 1 **pyrazolam** sample was **phenazolam** instead
- 1 unspecified benzo was **ethylbromazolam**

## DISSOCIATIVES & PSYCHEDELICS, 17 SAMPLES

- 9/11 samples were **ketamine**
  - 1 sample was **cocaine** (soft) instead
  - 1 sample was **MDMA** instead
- 1 **2C-B** sample was **ketamine, MDMA, and methamphetamine** instead
- 1 sample was **2C-I**
- 2 samples were **5-MeO-DMT**
- 1 sample was **LSD**
- 1 **tucibi** sample was **ketamine, MDMA, methamphetamine, and procaine**

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## STIMULANTS, 38 SAMPLES

- 16/17 samples were **cocaine** (hard and soft)
  - 1 sample did not have any actives detected
- 8/8 samples were **MDMA**
- 1/4 samples were **methamphetamine**
  - 3 samples did not have any actives detected
- 3/3 samples were **3-MMC**
- 4/4 samples were **4-MMC**
- 0/2 samples were **amphetamine**
  - 2 samples were **methamphetamine** instead

## OTHER, 19 SAMPLES

- 4/4 samples were **caffeine**
- 1 sample was **xylazine**
- 1 **zopiclone** sample was **zolpidem (Ambien)** instead
- 1 **codeine & promethazine (Lean)** sample did not have any actives detected
- 1/2 samples was **hydromorphone (Dilaudid)**
  - 1 sample did not have any actives detected
- 3/6 samples were **oxycodone (Oxycontin)**
  - 1 sample was **diclofenac** instead
  - 2 samples did not have any actives detected
- 0/2 samples were **Percocet**
  - 2 samples did not have any actives detected
- 1 **Viagra & Cialis** sample also contained **acetaminophen (Tylenol)**
- 1 sample was **oxandrolone**

## UNKNOWN, 13 SAMPLES

- 13 samples were brought in as "unknown"
  - 9 samples had actives detected, 4 did not



## REPORT GLOSSARY

- **Median:** Like an average, but accounts for outlying results so the final number isn't skewed.
- **Percentages:** Represents the amount per 100 mg. Example: a concentration of 12% fentanyl is 12 mg of fentanyl per 100 mg (a point) of the total sample (including other components like cuts).
- **Unknown benzo:** A benzo that is likely outside of our PSMS target list.
- **Fentanyl or analogue:** Results based on a positive strip test and unconfirmed by PSMS.
