

SUBSTANCE WEEKLY REPORT



July 6th - July 12th, 2026 (192 Samples)

HIGHLIGHTS

- 54.7% (105/192) of samples checked this week were as expected, with no cuts or adulterants detected
- 31.2% (15/48) of down samples contained a benzo this week

DOWN/OPIOIDS, 48 SAMPLES

- 35 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 3%
- 31 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at a median concentration of 9%
- 9 samples contained **medetomidine** at a median concentration of 1%
- 7 samples contained **heroin** at a median concentration of 1%
- 2 samples contained **ortho-methyl fentanyl**, at concentrations of 1% and 40%
- 15/48 down samples contained a **benzo**
 - 7 samples contained **ethylbromazepam** at a median concentration of 3%
 - 3 samples contained **phenazepam** at concentrations of 2%, 7%, and 15%
 - 2 samples contained **desalkylgidazepam**, both at concentrations of less than 1%
 - 1 sample contained **ethylflualprazolam** at a concentration of 2%
 - 1 sample contained **meclonazepam** at a concentration of 2%
 - 1 sample contained an **unknown benzo**

Over the Past Four Weeks...

- 163 samples contained **fentanyl** at a median concentration of 3%
- 118 samples contained **fluorofentanyl** at a median concentration of 7%
- 48 samples contained **medetomidine** at a median concentration of 1%
- 30 samples contained **ethylbromazepam** at a median concentration of 3%
- 10 samples contained **ortho-methyl fentanyl** at a median concentration of 2%

BENZOS, 9 SAMPLES

- 0/4 samples was **alprazolam (Xanax)**
 - 2 samples were **phenazepam** instead
 - 1 sample was **flualprazolam** instead
 - 1 sample was **ethylflualprazolam** instead
- 1 **bromazepam** sample was **ethylbromazepam** instead
- 1 sample was **clonazepam (Klonopin)**
- 1 sample was **diazepam (Valium)**
- 1 sample was **phenazepam**
- 1 unspecified benzo sample was **lorazepam (Ativan)** and **quetiapine (Seroquel)**

DISSOCIATIVES & PSYCHEDELICS, 19 SAMPLES

- 9/9 samples were **ketamine**
- 4/4 samples were **2C-B**
- 1 **AL-LAD** sample was **4-AcO-DMT** instead
- 1 **DMT** sample was **5-MeO-DMT** instead
- 1 sample was **DPT**
- 2/2 samples were **LSD (acid)**
- 1 sample was **mescaline**

UNKNOWN, 8 SAMPLES

- 8 samples were brought in as "unknown"
 - 7 samples had actives detected, 1 did not

STIMULANTS, 84 SAMPLES

- 33/35 samples were **cocaine** (hard and soft)
 - 2 **cocaine** (soft) samples also contained **fluorofentanyl**
- 2/2 samples were **MDA**
- 24/31 were **MDMA**
 - 3 samples were **MDA** instead
 - 1 sample also contained **cocaine** (soft)
 - 1 sample was **ketamine** instead
 - 1 sample was **2C-B** instead
 - 1 sample did not have any actives detected
- 7/7 samples were **methamphetamine**
- 1 sample was **2-MMC**
- 4/5 samples were **4-MMC**
 - 1 sample was **4-CMC** instead
- 3/3 samples were **amphetamine**

OTHER, 24 SAMPLES

- 1 **caffeine** sample also contained **fentanyl**
- 3/3 samples were **GHB**
- 1 **hydromorphone (Dilaudid)** sample was **bromazolam, fentanyl, N-Propionyl Para-Fluoro Norfentanyl** instead
- 1 sample was **oxycodone (Oxycontin)**
- 3/3 samples were **SR-17018**
- 1 sample was **tramadol**
- 1 sample was **amoxicillin trihydrate**
- 1 sample was **bromazolam** and **methamphetamine**, as expected
- 1 **semaglutide** sample did not have any actives detected
- 1 **sildenafil (Viagra)** was **tadalafil (Cialis)** instead
- 1/3 samples was **tadalafil (Cialis)**
 - 1 sample also contained **cocaine** (soft)
 - 1 sample also contained an unknown
- 1 **varidenafil (Levitra)** sample was **tadalafil (Cialis)** instead
- 5 steroid samples did not have any actives detected
- 1 **testosterone undecanoate** sample was **trenbolone enanthate** instead

REPORT GLOSSARY

- **Median:** Like an average, but accounts for outlying results so the final number isn't skewed.
- **Percentages:** Represents the amount per 100 mg. Example: a concentration of 12% fentanyl is 12 mg of fentanyl per 100 mg (a point) of the total sample (including other components like cuts).
- **Unknown benzo:** A benzo that is likely outside of our PSMS target list.
- **Fentanyl or analogue:** Results based on a positive strip test and unconfirmed by PSMS.
